

GRADING SYSTEM OF CORK INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

MODULES:

The normal pass mark in a module is 40%

A combination of mandatory and elective modules amounting to 60 ECTS credits is required to pass a stage (year).

STAGES AND AWARDS:

The normal pass mark in a stage (year) is 40%

For Higher Certificate or Bachelor Degree, overall results in a stage (year) are classified as follows:

Merit Grade 2:	at least 50% of the total credit-weighted marks
Merit Grade 1:	at least 60% of the total credit-weighted marks
Distinction:	at least 70% of the total credit-weighted marks


For an Honours Bachelor Degree overall results in a stage (year) are classified as follows:

Second Class Honours, Grade 2:	at least 50% of the total credit-weighted marks
Second Class Honours, Grade 1:	at least 60% of the total credit-weighted marks
First Class Honours:	at least 70% of the total credit-weighted marks.

Taught Masters Degrees (through Coursework and Dissertation) are classified as follows:

First Class:	at least 70% of the total credit-weighted marks
Second Class:	at least 60% of the total credit-weighted marks.

Research Masters and Doctoral Degrees are unclassified, and are equivalent to honours standard.
